Dear parents/carers

Today we were very pleased to see 93% of our students at school. There were many smiling faces as students returned and were warmly welcomed back.

As in line with State Government directions, we are now expecting all children to return to school unless they:

- have a medical referral to learn from home; or
- are unwell.

If your child/children are unwell, have symptoms of cold or fever, please keep them home until they are better. Seek medical advice if you are concerned. Please inform the school so we can record the absence as a medical reason. If a child does not attend school and an explanation is not received, the absence will be recorded as an unauthorised absence.

School Assembly

This week's assembly will be a virtual one, with the Drumbeat performance, Honour Certificates and presentation of student leader badges filmed separately on Tuesday afternoon. A link will be sent to teachers who will view the assembly with classes on Wednesday. The link will also be uploaded to parents via connect and our school website.

COVID-19 Education Assistance package from NBN

NBN is providing funding to assist phone and internet providers to support low-income family households with school-aged children, who do not currently have an active NBN connection at home. This funding will help phone and internet providers create more affordable offers to connect eligible families during Term 2.

If parents and carers want to take advantage of these offers, they can contact internet providers and ask for special COVID-19 deals. The participating provider will help determine if parents and carers are eligible for assistance. It is important they read the terms and conditions of the offers carefully.

Schools will not provide any personal information about parents or carers to internet providers.
