

Dear Parents/Carers

Thank you for your continued support as we work together managing COVID restrictions. We have come a long way since the start of term and with the end of term in sight, it is good to see the happy vibe returning to school life.

The State Government has now announced that we have progressed to Phase 4 of the WA Roadmap to recovery. Consequently, the Education Department, in line with the latest health advice, has reviewed operating guidelines for Western Australian Public Schools.

At Bannister Creek Primary School this means that:

- The current pick-up and drop-off arrangements will continue. Parents may enter the school site to deliver or collect children from classrooms, but due to physical distancing requirements must not enter classrooms at drop off or pick up times.
- Kindergarten hours will continue to be modified- **8:40am to 2:35pm**, (children released 10mins earlier than Years PP to 6).
- Parents may come on to the school site to attend meetings that have been pre-booked via email, phone, Seesaw or Connect.
- The Parent/Teacher Early Close Interviews cancelled in Term 1 will be re-scheduled to early August (date to be confirmed).
- In Term 3 School Assemblies will resume for students. Parents are not able to attend due to the adult physical distancing requirement of one person per two square meters. We will continue to film assemblies and send the link to parents.
- Classroom parent help rosters will not resume until the physical distancing requirement has been lifted.
- Excursions and interschool sporting events will resume in Term 3

Term 2 finishes next Friday, 3<sup>rd</sup> July. Term 3 commences on **Monday, 20<sup>th</sup> July**.
